

Welcome!! You will need the following information in order to complete this Team Registration for participation in the Emerald Coast Competition on February 10th, 2024:

Deadlines:

Team registration closes on Dec. 15, 2023. Judge & worker registration closes on January 6, 2024.

Tournament Registration:

The tournament fee covers both the Florida Registration and Regional Registration fees.

- Division I-IV: \$150
- Primary Teams: \$125

Should your team advance to the State Tournament there is an additional registration fee.

Judge & Worker Requirement:

- Each team is required to supply a judge who must be registered by Jan. 6, 2024 as part of tournament registration. Any team provided judge who does not participate in the online and in person Judges Training or the Tournament could be incurred a \$100 fine and the team risks a 25 point penalty.
- Each team is required to supply 1 worker who must be registered by Jan. 6, 2024 as part of tournament registration.

Scheduling Conflicts:

Please use the Schedule field to notify us of any CRITICAL scheduling issues the Tournament Director needs to know. This includes:

- Team members competing on multiple teams
- Coaches coaching multiple teams
- Significant commitments by a team member and the time of day the team member cannot be present.

While there are no guarantees, every effort to schedule your team around these commitments will be made.

Photo Opt-Out:

Please be aware that we will be taking photos and videos at all Regional events. We will use these images to create informational, promotional, and fundraising DVD's and printed materials. We will not identify teams or individuals with additional captions. Please be advised our tournaments take place in public forums. We cannot control the general public's ability to snap a picture and post it on social media. We do make every effort to honor a team's request for no photos or videos during the long term performance IF presented by the team to the staging judge.





WORKER INFORMATION

We simply cannot hold a tournament without our Volunteer Workers. In order for all aspects of a tournament to run smoothly a single Regional Tournament can need anywhere from 80+ Workers & Volunteers.

Workers will be assigned to their Role and time prior to tournament to ensure all roles and time slots are covered. Positions and times are given so that workers are allowed to see their teams perform. Work shifts can last anywhere between 2-3 hours.



The judge is required to attend training on 3 Feb 9-2 and serve at the tournament 10 Feb all day. Judges will <u>not</u> be able to see their children's performances

OFFICIALS INFORMATION

We simply cannot hold a tournament without our Officials & Judges. In order to maintain a fair and even playing field ALL Officials are required to attend training sessions. A single Regional Tournament can need anywhere from 80+ Officials.

Judges will be assigned to their Role and Problem prior to training to ensure all roles and problems are covered. Relations to team members will be taken into consideration when assigning official and judging roles.

All Officials will be given a lanyard on tournament day. This lanyard is to be worn at the tournament. Officials will not be able to see their own children's performance.

Only registered judges can attend the judges training.

Emeraid Coast Region — Official/Judge Requirements Each team is required to supply a judge who must be registered by January 4, 2023 as part of your tournament registration. Any team provided judge who does not show to Judges Training or the Tournament could incur a \$100 fine and the team risks a 25-point penalty.
